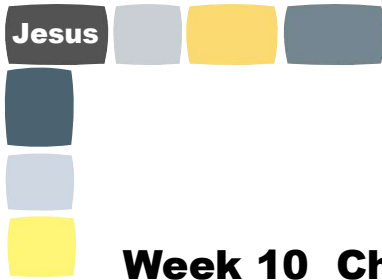

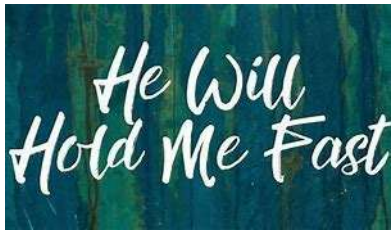

That includes living through this coronavirus pandemic where there is no quick fix, no inoculation (at least not yet) and no button to press that will make it all go away. But we do have a Father who will never forget or abandon His children.

God has promised to keep us in "perfect peace" it's perfect because it's source is the Prince of Peace, the Lord Jesus. All we have to do is dig into the riches of the Gospel and keep in mind the wonders of His love. Fixing our gaze on Jesus is much better than fixing our eyes on our fears, Like Peter who walked on water as he fixed his eyes on Jesus but when he lowered his eyes onto the problems around him, he began to sink.

Jesus is the "living stone" (1 Peter 2:4-8) He's the "everlasting Rock", the Rock of ages. God calls us to trust Jesus, just like collapsing onto a soft bed at the end of a bad day. It's not the quality of our trust that's important, but the trustworthiness of Jesus that matters, so the pressures off, and we rest in His peace.

What an amazing Heavenly Father we have, how great is His mercy and profound is His kindness to us.

What a Saviour Jesus is - our perfect righteousness and sovereign King, He will hold us fast, when everything else seems so very fragile and uncertain.
